- A5 Bookbag with zip closure (Tuckshop)
- 1 Pritt (big) per term

Play Dough (Recipe) (or teddy dough)

- 250ml flour
- 100ml salt
- 15ml crème of tartar
- 225ml water
- 15ml oil
- Food colouring

1. PLACE ALL INGREDIENTS INTO A POT, STIR OVER A HIGH HEAT UNTIL LUMPY.
2. SWITCH STOVE OFF AND STIR WELL.
3. WAIT UNTIL DOUGH COOL OFF AND KNEAD UNTIL SMOOTH.
4. DIVIDE DOUGH INTO 4 EQUAL PARTS TO MAKE 4 DIFFERENT COLOURS!!
